This is my third time applying for the Recreation Commission. I am committed to their mission of "providing our community with a variety of opportunities for safe, memorable and quality activities for all ages, interests and abilities..."

Involvement:

In the past, I have attended meetings, several of which were cancelled due to lack of a quorum.

I often attend the Senior luncheons. My husband played Co-ed softball for years and coached a Brentwood baseball team. Our two youngest children played baseball and soccer at the Brentwood Rec.

There are several things I like about the Rec. Senior luncheons is one. I also appreciate Andy's willingness to speak with me, even when we don't agree.

But, I believe, there are areas that need improvement such as the physical building. We need new windows, furnace and AC improvements, possible new stove/oven. I believe that our building should be rented out a minimum of 70 times/year, but can't be in its current shape.

I am willing to help with the Snack Shack and a list of volunteers. I believe that the teams that use our field should help with the Shack or pay extra. I also believe that we should pursue sponsorship banners on the fields.

I have suggested a few programs including: grandparents morning once a month. This would potentially unite residents in 3 Ponds with other seniors in Brentwood. I would also like a driving assist for seniors, but this needs more research on liability.

I would like to help the Recreation Department be even better than it is.
