The Recreation Committee met and reviewed current/future programs, as well as, past events/programs

- Kelly called the meeting to order at 6:30pm, seconded by McIntyre, all were in favor.
- Members reviewed and approved of the minutes.
- Farrell updated the board on how men's basketball is going and there have been no major injuries.
- Gray notified the board that youth basketball is doing well overall. With that said Gray did note that the youth refs need more works and need to make more calls and at the 3rd-4th grade level the Greenland v Brentwood girls game got out of hand due to parent and coaches behavior. Gray will attend the next game between the two towns and McIntyre will be speaking with the youth refs for further improvement.
- Calls to the North Pole went very well, only a few calls missed.
- The Brentwood & Kingston Christmas Carroll trip went well but only 2 Brentwood residents went on the trip.
- The decking project is moving along, front steps & kitchen deck are very close to being completed and the ramp has an expected completion date prior to the February 1st Daddy Daughter Dance. After the decking project Kip Kiser will be working with Gray to look at completing the window project as that is the next piece of the facility that needs major repair/replacement.
- Fall fun run is scheduled for Saturday, October 5th from 9am-11am.
- Rogers gave an update on how the Holiday Stroll went and that each year there is continued improvement and more participants.
- The board reviewed the revolving account with a balance of \$24,357.56.
- Gray notified the board that the communications board is need of pictures and member bios for the new town website.
- Gray reviewed what upcoming capital projects need to stay on the boards radar. Most of them refer to facility additions or improvements for public health reasons.
- Morgan updated the board on how the road project is moving along and that the project is approved and will be scheduled for work in March with an expected completion by end of April.
- Gray is working on notes and a potential contract that the selectboard will review for the Brentwood & Kingston van agreement.
- Gray has a meeting with Janice from the library on 1/23 to discuss potential senior programs and trips. There is a senior luncheon on January 23rd and Gray has a meeting on 1/18 with Shelia Combs to discuss fundraisers and potential senior trips.
- Gray updated the board he expects a 100% return rate of counselors with the potential addition of a sub counselor and that the camp will have two beach days a week at the Kingston Rec beach.

Gray is going to send the board a list of programs and events at their current rates and the board will look to adjust rates at the February meeting.
